Section A - Applicant

In this section enter the information on the entity "Applicant" applying for access to the ISIN code service, Art. 129 consolidated banking law reporting and Securitizations. Once authorized, the Applicant will be registered as a "Partner" in the Infostat system.

A.2 Applicant identification code

Applicants in possession of an ABI code have to enter the ABI code with check digit (A.2.1) and the Italian Tax ID code (A.2.2), other Italian entities have to enter only the Italian Tax ID code.

Non-residents have to fill the TAX/VAT code field (A.2.3).

For all the applicants enter, if available, the LEI code (A.2.4).

A.3 Applicant information

Enter a valid functional e-mail (no certified email) which will receive all the automatic response messages of the procedure. Please note that this email is common to all uses of the Infostat procedure by the applicant and will therefore also receive communications from the other procedures.

A.4 Registered office of the applicant

The province field (A.4.2) and ZIP code (A.4.4) marked with ** are mandatory only for resident applicants.

Section B - Contact person information

This section contains the information of the person nominee "Contact person" to receive the communications of the ISIN code service, Art. 129 consolidated banking law reporting and Securitizations. The contact person, employee of the applicant, will initially be granted the status of service administrator and may authorize/revoke other persons (operators) to act on behalf of the Applicant like administrator/operator.
