

We inform web users that, on January 11th 2010, the Venezuelan Government introduced two different exchange rates for the national currency against the US Dollar, depending on the kind of transactions, both commercial and financial, for which the domestic currency might be needed. Therefore, in addition to the information already available in the "Exchange rates" website section we provide, listed below, the average rate for the year 2010 of the Bolivar Fuerte (ISO code: VEF; UIC code: 277) and the old Bolivar (ISO code: VEB; UIC code: 035).
