Banca d'Italia Gender Economics Workshop Rome – 12 December 2025

Submission Deadline: 13 July 2025

The Banca d'Italia Gender Economics Workshop will take place in Rome on 12 December 2025. The aim of the workshop is to bring together leading and emerging economists working on topics related to gender economics, with a particular focus on the policy implications to tackle gender inequalities.

Although we invite submissions on a broader set of topics, we particularly welcome papers on:

- Gender wage gaps: differences in firm-level wage setting, bargaining power, negotiation skills.
- The child penalty and its sources.
- Gender gaps in human capital accumulation, the role of fields of study and school performance.
- Policies to improve women's labour market outcomes and foster overall economic growth.
- The impact of technology and AI on gender disparities in the labour market.

The keynote speaker will be Camille Landais (London School of Economics).

Funding

The workshop will be held at the headquarters of the Banca d'Italia in Rome. Financial support for economy class air travel and 1-night hotel accommodation (2 nights for non-European travellers) will be provided to all speakers who request it at the time of submission (further details about the Banca d'Italia reimbursement guidelines will be provided upon acceptance). A social dinner will be held the evening before the workshop.
