2nd Banca d'Italia Annual Research Conference on Monetary Policy

Banca d'Italia, Rome, 18-19 June 2026

Submission Deadline: March 2, 2026

Banca d'Italia will host the second edition of the Annual Research Conference on Monetary Policy. The conference will bring together economists from academia and central banks to discuss key issues in the conduct of monetary policy. Both theoretical and empirical papers making contributions to monetary economics and monetary policy are welcome. Special attention will be given to papers with relevance to current policy questions.

Relevant topics include, but are not limited to:

- Monetary policy with information frictions
- Monetary policy and uncertainty
- Central bank communication
- Inflation expectations, anchoring, and inflation dynamics
- Monetary policy and structural changes, fragmentation, and supply chain disruptions
- Monetary-fiscal policy interactions
- Implications of heterogeneity and inequality for monetary policy.

Keynote speakers: Prof. Fernando Alvarez (University of Chicago) and Prof. Michael Woodford (Columbia University).
