This volume brings together the papers presented at the ninth Banca d'Italia Public Finance Workshop, held in Perugia from 29 to 31 March, 2007.

The Workshop examined four issues that are at the centre of the current fiscal policy debate: the roles of fiscal stabilisers and discretionary policy, the factors in the success of fiscal consolidation, the relationship between budgetary institutions and fiscal policy, and the control of public expenditure.
