The completely transformed Money Museum was reopened after 10 years

- Completely renewed, the Money Museum opened its doors to the public on 15 March 2022, after almost ten years.
- The exhibition uses the latest interactive and educational digital tools to show the role of money in our everyday lives.
- The museum is open to the public free of charge following pre-registration.
- The exhibition and its contents are also available to visitors in English and Chinese.

The numismatic collection on display is internationally unique


- The Money Museum has a coin collection of over 60,000 coins, the second largest numismatic collection in the country.
- Our tasks include the professional administration, digitisation and protection of the collection. The digitised material is also available to researchers.
- The Museum also has a collection of banking history, which preserves documents and special artefacts from the Bank's past.





The Money Museum also hosts temporary art and professional exhibitions

- The museum has a temporary exhibition space where professional, artistic and contemporary exhibitions can be held.
- Each year, the exhibition space will host several exhibitions with professional or artistic themes.
- Currently, we have an exhibition entitled The History of Buda Palace (Saving Values -Creating Values), but we also plan to work on the following themes: Counterfeiting, Illustrations on banknotes.





In its unique space, events can also be held

- The Money Museum can also host a variety of small events and professional conferences.
- The venue can accommodate 60 to 100 people depending on the seating arrangements.
- We can provide on-site catering service, equipment and technical facilities for events.
- Museum visits, museum educational activities and individual gift packages are also available as part of the museum's services.
